English is the language of science, therefore teaching of science in Norwegian will end up with English terms entangled in Norwegian vocabulary. It might be easier for both students and teachers if more subjects were taught in English. Nonetheless, the stress on nationalizing scientific terms should be put elsewhere - on organizing more advanced courses in science communication. The issue of translating English scientific terms into Norwegian should be dealt there and not during other lectures.

The Norwegian classes offered by UiO for newly employed international personnel are not sufficient. If UiO insists on international employees to become fluent in Norwegian, they should organize free-of-charge proper courses ending in B2-level examination.
